4th Annual Roselawn Easter Parade and Egg Hunt

The Roselawn Easter Parade and Egg Hunt took place on **Easter Sunday, March 31**st. This was the 4th year that the Greenbriar/Brentwood Neighborhood held an Easter Parade for the children of the neighborhood to enjoy. With each year that passes, this event continues to grow larger.

On the afternoon of Easter Sunday, the people of the neighborhood met at the snowball/crawfish stand at the corner of Johnston Street and Roselawn Blvd. There they were greeted by the Easter bunny, local law enforcement officials & medical personnel. The children were able to take pictures with the Easter Bunny and tour police cars, firetrucks & the ambulance. After everyone finished gathering, they paraded down Roselawn Blvd towards Grace Presbyterian Church, with the police officers leading the way. The kids of the neighborhood had decorated their bikes & wagons for the parade and the neighbors that live on Roselawn sat outside greeting everyone as they passed by.

Once at Grace Church, 3 egg hunts took place (by age group). Local businesses donated gift certificates & other items for the children to enjoy and to be able to receive prizes. This year we had 77 children participate in the egg hunts. We also had 2 boy scout troops participate in the hiding of the eggs.




Committee Meetings



BETTY'S CORN CASSEROLE

1 can cream-style corn (14 oz)

1 can whole kernel corn (14 oz)

1 tbsp sugar

½ cup yellow corn meal

2 cups milk (divided)

5 tbsp cooking oil

 $1/3 - \frac{1}{2}$ cup bell pepper

1 med chopped onion

1 stick melted butter

1 sleeve Ritz crackers (crushed)

1 egg

Sauté onion and bell pepper in cooking oil. Add corn meal and cook for 1 min, stirring constantly. Add corn and 1-3/4 cup milk, stirring constantly until mixture begins to thicken. Mix egg and ¼ cup milk and add to mixture, stirring constantly until thick. Place in buttered 9x13 casserole dish. Mix crackers with melted butter and spread on top. Bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes.

Serves 12-16
