Finishing Easter

Well, another Easter Sunday has come and gone! Somewhat like Christmas, the lead-up to Easter begins early, and includes the purchasing of new Easter outfits, shopping and planning for a family feast, and, of course, the candy!

For many, Easter Sunday begins with a sunrise service, continues through the usual morning worship service—when everyone gets to show off those aforementioned Easter clothes—and the Easter meal with family and/or friends.

Here at Grace, we have helped establish a new Easter tradition in our neighborhood, of an Easter parade down Roselawn Boulevard, culminating in an Easter egg hunt on the church grounds—all of which extends Easter Sunday into a longer and, hopefully, a slightly more satisfying day! We hope that the latter activities make for more family time, and a new family tradition, even for people who might not include worship in their Easter schedule.

In the church, we are still celebrating Easter, because for us Easter is a season that lasts for seven weeks! We place a special emphasis on the Resurrection—Christ risen from death—until Pentecost.

All the Easter candy is long gone, and some of the Easter outfits may even have been passed on or resold on Poshmark; but we are tarrying to ponder the significance and meaning of the Resurrection, not only for Jesus, but for ourselves!

Easter is a celebration of the central message of our faith: that God sent his only Son for our salvation; and Jesus, who died on the cross at the hands of sinners like ourselves, rose bodily from the grave, preparing the way for us have eternal life if we believe in him. We "finish Easter" when we accept for ourselves this marvelous gift of God by believing in his son, Jesus Christ. That's what it's all about!



The Church Office will be closed on Monday, May 27th to observe Memorial Day. Church Staff will be back in the office on Tuesday Morning.




Four Special Guests

The Presbyterian Women's Birthday Offering 2024

Grace's Presbyterian Women will celebrate their Birthday on **Sunday**, **May 19**th.

The Birthday Offering is one of Presbyterian Women's two offerings. It gives women a tangible way to celebrate the blessings in their lives. This offering funds projects each year, in amounts of \$75,000 to \$150,000 each.

This year's recipients are:

1. Advocates for Community Choice dba
Bethel Hills Villa 5 Apartments &
Recreation Area (Marthasville, MO)
Bethel Hills addresses the unique needs
of individuals with intellectual /
developmental disabilities by providing a
safe & loving place that takes into
account their physical, emotional and
spiritual needs in an environment where
they can flourish. By renovating a villa
into 4 accessible apartments for 8
individuals, this project will provide
housing that takes into consideration
specific needs unique to their residents.

2. Shawnee Presbyterian Church Café

Gingko (Louisville, KY)
Located in an economically
disadvantaged area where single mothers
& children face challenges of food
insecurity. With the Birthday Offering
grant, Café Gingko will be able to reopen
with a renovated kitchen & expanded
capacity to provide meals. Improvements
to the fellowship hall will allow the
church to offer enriching activities:
tutoring for elementary ages, play zone,
financial literacy classes and mama-tomama parenting workshops.

There will be a basket in the back of the Sanctuary on <u>Sunday</u>, <u>May 19th</u> for those who wish to donate to the Birthday Offering.

BREAD PUDDING (with Rum Sauce)

6 slices white bread torn in small pieces (crust, too)

2 cups milk

1 Tablespoon margarine

2 eggs, beaten

1-1/4 cups sugar

1/4 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon cinnamon

1 teaspoon vanilla

½ cup raisins

Place bread in a 9" round glass dish.
Heat milk and margarine on HIGH 3minutes in a 4-cup measure.
Stir in eggs and sugar. Add salt, cinnamon,
vanilla and raisins. Pour mixture over bread
pieces. Cook on HIGH 7-minutes.

RUM SAUCE

¼ cup margarine½ cup sugarAdd rum to taste

Heat margarine and sugar on HIGH 2-minutes in a 2-cup measure.

Add rum.

Serves 8.

Pentecost is such a special time in the church year. Sometimes referred to as the "birthday" of the church, many people choose to wear red on this particular Sunday, symbolizing the work of the Holy Spirit.

Pentecost arrives 50 days after Easter and 10 days after the Ascension — when Jesus ascends into heaven. Just before he ascends, Jesus gives us the Great Commission found in Matthew 28:16-20 and Acts 1:8.

Jesus and the Scriptures make an important point for us to remember as we celebrate Pentecost. Jesus ascends and the church is born. If his mission and ministry is to continue, it is upon us, his continuing hands and feet in the world, to keep it going, always led by the Holy Spirit, who blesses us with different gifts that work together to do God's ministry in the world.

Each year on Pentecost Sunday, we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit and the birthday of the church. The Holy Spirit remains with us still, connecting us with the church of the past, continuing to inspire the church of today, and pointing us to the church of the future.

This year Pentecost is celebrated on **Sunday, May 19**th.
